

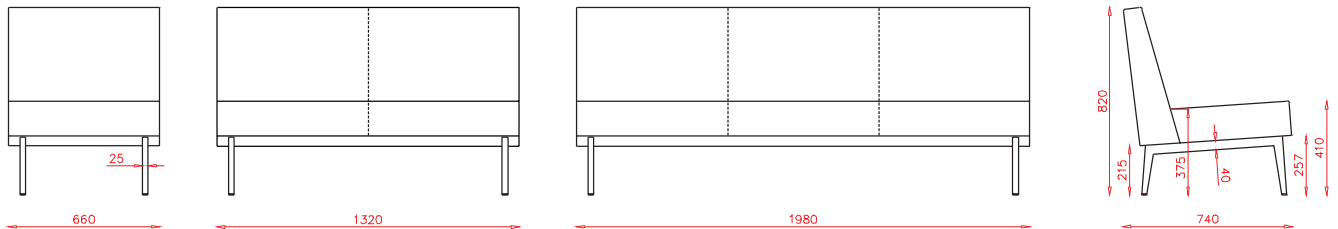

### Materials

Frame: plywood, chipboard

Upholstery: combined 80 kg/m<sup>3</sup> RE (rebound R-type foam) – 30 mm and 50 kg/m<sup>3</sup> HR (high resilience) – 60 mm layers of polyurethane on zigzag springs in the seat; 40 kg/m<sup>3</sup> HR (high resilience) 60mm layer of polyurethane in the backrest.

Cover: textile  
vinyl  
leather

Legs: painted metal frame (rectangular tube 40x25mm and 30x30mm, powder coating, antracite grey (RAL 7016)), plastic glides.
